

Golf Blazers 8th in John A. Logan Invitational

Marion, Ill., Mar. 30-31 – The Vincennes University golf team finish eighth in the 12-team John A. Logan Spring Invitational at the par 72, 7,205 yard Kokopelli Golf Club in Marion, Ill.

Logan won the event with a team-low 610 strokes while South Mountain, Ariz., finished second (615). Vincennes was 57 strokes off the winning pace with a 667.

VU sophomore Chris Taylor was medalist for the Blazers with 10-over par, 154 (79-75).
