#### A New Building!

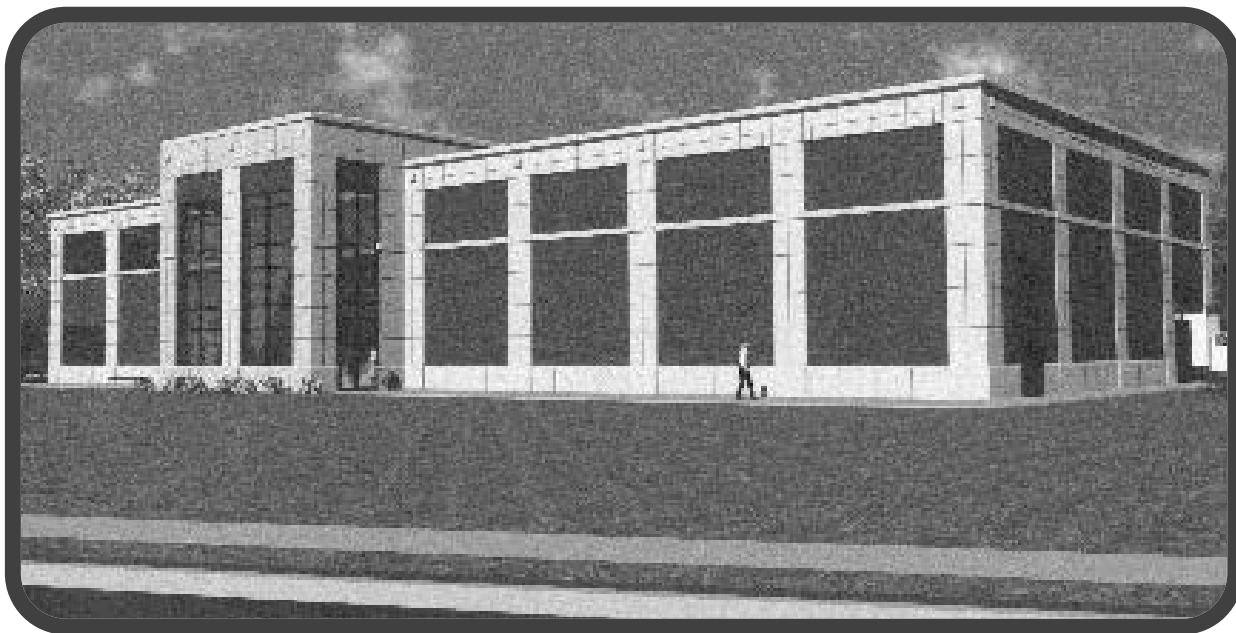
On November 14, 2002, Vincennes University held a groundbreaking ceremony for a new Construction Technology building. The building will have over 29,268 square feet. This building will house two-lecture classrooms and several specialized lab areas including a framing and finish carpentry lab, masonry lab, electrical lab, and a cabinet and mill shop. In addition, there will also be conference rooms, faculty offices, and a student lounge area. Occupation for the new building is scheduled for the fall semester of 2003. The Construction Technology faculty and students are excited and are looking forward to occupying the new building.

Since 1967, the Construction Technology program has been housed in several locations on the Vincennes University campus. Some of these locations have included: the Wabash Coffee Warehouse, Beless Gymnasium, the Entomology Building, and our present location the Old Armory Building.

As Program Coordinator of the Construction Technology program, I would like to thank a few individuals who are responsible for keeping the program a viable entity. Mr. Benard Niehaus (Chairman of Niehaus Home Center and former Chair of the Vincennes University Board of Trustees) for having a vision and the persistence to implement such a wonderful instructional program to serve the building industry and the residents of Indiana. ## BUILDING MAINTENANCE

### A Two-Year Program Leading to the A.A.S. or A.S. Degree

Building Maintenance is a one-year program designed to prepare a student for apartment and condominium maintenance. Students are trained in carpentry, concrete, masonry, blue print reading, electrical wiring, plumbing, HVAC and small engines.

#### CNST 100 Construction Seminar

**1 hours (Sem I)**

A course designed to expose students to recent trends in the residential construction industry. Information is presented concerning materials, occupations and professional organizations within the industry. Guest speakers provide such information when available. 1 hour lecture.

#### CNST 105 Framing

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

A course devoted to rough framing. It includes building codes, floor framing, wall framing, roof framing, stair framing and general use of the steel square. Information on types and methods of construction will be presented in the classroom. The laboratory section will provide opportunities to practice framing in mock-up situations. Field trips will be scheduled if houses in rough framing construction are available. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 120 Construction Safety

**2 hours (Sem I, II)**

A course that focuses on safety practices to be followed during residential construction. Emphasis is placed on the Occupational Safety and Health Administrations Safety and Health Standards for the construction industry. 2 lecture hours.

#### CNST 155 Electrical Wiring

**2 hours (Sem I, II)**

Information is given regarding installing and connecting component parts of residential wiring in a manner which is workable and acceptable according to the National Electrical Code. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 160 Finish Carpentry

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

Students are introduced to products and instructed in their applications in the residential building industry. Instruction includes wall covering, floor covering, ceilings, paint, hardware, millwork, specialty products, doors and windows. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 180 Concrete and Masonry

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

Students plan foundation, footings, walks, and driveways. They are instructed on the types of bonds and materials used to construct walls. Composition of the materials is also covered. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 205 Residential House Construction I

**8 hours (Sem I)**

Prerequisite: A grade of C or better in TBM 105, 120, 155, 160 and 180. The first of two courses in house construction. Details of residential house construction will be covered including foundation installation, floor and wall framing, roofing insulation, wiring, door and window installation. Students will be given necessary on-the-job experiences to understand the problems of the use of materials and equipment. Houses will be constructed as a result of these courses. 22 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 210 Mechanical Systems

**2 hours (Sem I, II)**

Information is given regarding installation of residential fresh water distribution, drainage, waste and ventilation in a manner that is workable and acceptable to the plumbing codes. Insulation, moisture control, ventilation and HVAC topics are covered in relationship to required energy standards. 2 lecture hours.

#### CNST 250 Residential House Construction II

**8 hours (Sem II)**

Prerequisite: A grade of C or better in TBM 205. A continuation of TBM 205, including interior and exterior finish. 22 laboratory hours.

#### \*CNST 255 Construction Material Takeoff

**3 hours (Sem I)**

Students learn to complete material takeoff for residential buildings. The entire course involves the practice of estimating materials; therefore, a prior knowledge of the kinds and qualities of materials used in residential construction is essential. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 260 Problems in Remodeling

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

Students are instructed in the problems commonly found when adding an addition, updating a structure, and restructuring a building. The problems involved in planning kitchens, baths, and other rooms are included. 3 lecture hours.

#### CNST 265 Cabinetmaking and Millwork

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

Instruction is given on those machines most likely found in a mill workshop and emphasis is placed on development of skills to the highest degree in tool operation. Information is given on the parts that constitute various types of casework. Laboratory time is available to develop skills in tool set-up and operation as well as construction and assembly of cabinet parts. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

#### \*§CNST 270 Construction Labor Rating and PricingR/W/S

**3 hours (Sem II)**

Prerequisites: Successful completion of HER 011, or recentered SAT Verbal score of (R)420 or greater, or appropriate placement test scores, and TBM 255. Material takeoff and labor rating data completed in TBM 255 will be used to determine the cost of a building. Making material price comparisons and a complete estimate of a house are required projects. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 290 Internship in Materials Merchandising

**2 hours (Sem I, II)**

Interested and qualified students may serve an internship with a building materials center. Internship is under the supervision of the coordinator of the Building Materials Marketing Option. A minimum of 160 hours of on-the-job training is required. The student's time should include 80 hours of yard duties (loading, storage, clean up, etc.) and 80 hours of in-store duties (stocking, pricing, merchandise display, signs, etc.). Minimum 160 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 291 Internship in Materials Merchandising

**3 hours (Sem I, II)**

Same as TBM 290 with an addition 80 hours devoted to consumer sales. A predetermined minimum sales volume will be established by the building supply dealer and the coordinator. Minimum 240 laboratory hours.

#### CNST 292 Internship in Materials Merchandising

**4 hours (Sem I, II)**

Will include all the elements of TBM 290 and 291 with an additional 80 hours spent on inventory control, accounts receivable, accounts payable, payroll, etc. Minimum of 320 laboratory hours.

### TTT 112 Fundamentals of Architectural Drafting 4 hours (Sem I)

Corequisite TDA 115. An introduction to basic concepts and practices of architectural drafting. Care and use of instruments, lettering, linework, geometric construction, and two- and three-dimensional drawing techniques will be presented and practiced. Students will then complete a set of working drawings for a residential structure. Drafting tools are required for individual use. 2 lecture hours, 6 laboratory hours.

### TDA 115 Architectural Materials I 2 hours (Sem I)

Corequisite TDA 110. A course designed to increase the student's knowledge of residential construction materials and how these materials are put together on a construction site. Field trips will be scheduled to a construction site to view construction materials and methods of installation. 2 lecture hours.

### TTT 161 Architectural Working Drawings 4 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: TTT 112. Corequisite: TDA 165. Course emphasis will be on light-commercial construction. Students will develop a complete set of drawings which will include HVAC, plumbing, electrical, and vertical circulation systems. There will be continued emphasis on lettering, linework, and cross-referencing skills. Drafting tools are required. 2 lecture hours, 6 laboratory hours.

### TDA 165 Architectural Materials II 2 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: TDA 115. Corequisite: TTT 161. Course content and discussion will be of the various materials and methods used and specified that are incorporated into commercial construction. A product resource file will be developed for academic and professional use. 2 lecture hours.

### TDA 185 Building Codes 1 hour (Sem II)

Course emphasis will include discussion and use of federal, state and local codes, including ADA requirements, as related to new or renovated construction. 1 lecture hour, 1 laboratory hour.

### TTT 190 Architectural Computer-Aided Drafting 3 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: TTT 140 or consent of instructor. Using AutoCAD for Windows, the course will include architectural drawing as related to light-frame construction. Students will be introduced to three-dimensional rendering and illustration. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

### TDA 210 Advanced Architectural Working Drawings 3 hours (Sem I)

Prerequisites: TTT 161 and TDA 185. This course introduces the concept of "State Approval Drawings". The student prepares a set of construction documents for a small commercial building that meets minimum state requirements. Continued emphasis is placed on lettering, linework, and techniques for professional communication of construction processes as well as the understanding of architectural technology. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

### TDA 230 Architectural Rendering and Illustration 3 hours (Sem I, II)

Prerequisite: TTT 102 or TTT 112 or consent of instructor. A course in the techniques of pictorial representation; exercises encompass multiview projection, shades, shadows, isometric drawing, perspective drawing and entourage. Media used may include pen and ink, pencil, water colors, air brush, felt pens, and various paper and board media to create the above listed illustrations and architectural scale models. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

### TDA 241 Intermediate Architectural CAD 4 hours (Sem I)

Prerequisite: TTT 190. Using AutoCAD and MS Windows, this course will emphasize various advanced architectural and engineering applications as related to commercial construction, along with other PC skills used in professional practice. 2 lecture hours, 6 laboratory hours.

### TDA 261 Architectural Capstone R/W/S 2 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisites: successful completion of HER 011, or recentered SAT verbal score of (R)420 or greater, or appropriate placement test scores, and TDA 210 and 241. Corequisite: TDA 291. This course will allow the student the opportunity to role play, conduct business/team meetings and deliver a product presentation. The student will also learn to synthesize the various team project requirements for a steel and/or concrete/masonry structure. Students will also calculate the quantity of materials required to erect a structure. 2 lecture hours.

### TDA 291 Advanced Architectural CAD 5 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisites: TDA 241. Corequisite: TDA 261. This course, along with TDA 261, provides a realistic opportunity to use CAD software and synthesize prior knowledge and experience, to create a set of bid documents for a steel and/or concrete/masonry commercial structure. This course emphasizes an increased level of professionalism within a team environment. 2 lecture hours, 10 laboratory hours.

### TTT 120 Computers for Technology 2 hours (Sem I, II)

This course is designed to meet the special computer needs of technology students. Computer software and hardware experiences, as they relate to the technology student, will be covered. No prior computer experience is assumed. This course fulfills the computer awareness requirement. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

### TTT 140 Introduction to CAD 3 hours (Sem I, II)

Prerequisite: Successful completion of HER 009, HEW 009 and SMA 009, or recentered SAT Verbal score of (R)370 or greater and SAT Math score of (R)330 or greater, or appropriate placement test scores or consent of instructor. Corequisite: TDI 110, TTT 101, 102, 104, or 112 or consent of instructor. Introduction to computer aided drafting using AutoCAD software. This course is designed as the first AutoCAD course for Industrial Drafting, Architectural Drafting and Surveying. Students interested in general computer graphics should take TTT 103 Introduction to Computer Graphics. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

### TTT 104 Surveying Fundamentals 3 hours (Sem I, II)

Corequisite: Enrollment in mathematics. Basic procedures employed in plane surveying; theory of errors and their analysis; theory and use of surveying equipment; accuracy appraisal and adjustment; development of surveying techniques and surveying computations using the level, chain, and transit. Cross-sectioning, simple traverses, slope staking, level networks and percent grades are also covered in detail. 2 lecture hours, 4 laboratory hours.

### AHI 155 Survey of Architectural History R/W 3 hours (Sem I, II)

Prerequisite: Successful completion of HER 011, or recentered SAT Verbal score of (R)420 or greater, or appropriate placement test scores. This course presents a survey of architectural history including various significant works dating from prehistoric times to the present. Students are introduced to the effects of cultural influences on the use, structure, and aesthetics of specific architectural works as well as recognized periods of history. 3 lecture hours.

### Approved Electives:

### TDA 251 3-D Studio 3 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: TDA 230 and/or prior experience with personal computers and an understanding of working with three dimensional space using computers. This course introduces the student to the 3-D Studio Graphics software package. 2 lecture hours, 2 laboratory hours.

### TDA 265 Introduction to Structures 3 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: SMT 107 or SMA 104. This course introduces the student to basic concepts of statics in structural analysis. The students increase their familiarity with major structural materials in terms of their unique reactions to structural loads and stresses. 3 lecture hours.

### TDA 281 Introduction to Design 4 hours (Sem II)

Prerequisite: TDA 230. This course introduces the student to the basic principles and elements of design by means of practical and abstract applications. Development of two and three dimensional solutions for conceptual design problems. Instruction will include lecture and critique in a design studio setting. 2 lecture hours, 6 laboratory hours.
