Please note the following important information related to student finances:

- The price of tuition, room and board goes up an average of 3% each year.
- International students are required to purchase medical insurance for the entire year (approximately \$300). Students must be prepared to pay for this on their own (not included on school bill).
- All students who are first year and under age 21 are required to live on campus for their first year. If students choose to live off campus, they will be responsible for their own apartment contract.
- Fees and the cost of books vary according to the program/major.
- Vincennes University does not generally provide scholarships for international students. All students however are eligible to apply and compete for academic scholarships in their second year at VU.

Payment and Wire Transfer Information

Please note that payment for all tuition, fees, room and board is due at the beginning of school. First time international students register for classes once they arrive and complete placement testing. After class registration, the student will be able to get their school account balance from the Financial Service Department or online.

Payment Options:

Option #1: pay entire school bill in full, due by Friday, September 2, 2011.

Option #2: Make 3 payments over 8 weeks: Payment plan fee is an extra \$30.00 for one semester. You will take your total bill and divide by three and make three payments.

1st payment due: **Friday, September 2, 2011 (first estimated payment amount: \$3000.00)**

2nd payment due: **Friday, September 23, 2011**

3rd and final payment due: **Friday, October 14, 2011 (full balance must be paid)**
