ENGL 102 English Composition II (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS M/W 7:30-10:30 PM
Instructor: Philip Beckett (evening class)

Prerequisite: Completion of ENGL 101 with a C or better. A continued development of writing skills introduced in ENGL 101. Students learn how to conduct research and how to base their writing on research. In addition to shorter documented papers, all students are required to write a longer investigative paper that must be fully documented according to MLA standards. 3 lecture hours. **Fulfills one English Core requirement.**

MATH 101 Intermediate Algebra (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS T/TH 4:30-7:30 PM
Instructor: Blake Miles (evening class)

Prerequisite: MATH 012 or DTMS Score of 14 or greater in AR and 27 or greater in EA. Systems of equations and inequalities, polynomials and exponents, factoring, rational expressions and equations, roots, radicals, and complex numbers, quadratic equations, and applications. 3 lecture hours. **This course is the prerequisite to MATH 102 College Algebra and fulfills a Broad Core elective.**

MGMT 260 Organizational Leadership (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS T/TH 4:30-7:30 PM
Instructor: Cdr. Todd Mitchell (evening class)

This course is the cornerstone of the organizational leadership program. The course will provide analysis of leadership through study of the major leadership theories throughout history. The course will also focus on how leadership works with change, problem solving, power, technology, decision making, and other issues inherent in guiding and facilitating an organization. 3 lecture hours. **Fulfills a 200 level elective and is an approved Business Studies elective.**

PSYC 142 General Psychology (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS T/TH 7:30 -10:30 PM
Instructor: Eva Shaw (evening class)

This course studies behavior studies behavior and cognitive processes as they affect man and other organisms, by focusing on the nervous systems, learning processes, research techniques, personality, motivation, etc. 3 lecture hours. **This course fulfills a Social Science requirement and is the prerequisite to all 200 level psychology courses.**

SOCL 151 Principles of Sociology (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS M/W 4:30 – 7:30 PM
Instructor: Claudia Macias (evening class)

Presents students with generalized information about the various social processes that function in society, various analytical tools, and techniques of applying this information to everyday living. 3 lecture hours. **This class fulfills one Social Science requirement or can be used as a 100 level elective.**

SPCH 143 Speech (8 Weeks) 3 CR HRS WED 5:00-7:30 PM
Instructors: Steve Netti (main instructor-Internet), Cliff Stuart (classroom) (evening class)

Introduces fundamental concepts and skills for effective public speaking including audience analysis, outlining, research, delivery, critical listening and evaluation, and the use of visual aids/technology. Required of all students. 3 lecture hours. **This class fulfills a speech requirement. **THIS IS A HYBRID COURSE*** 60% will be instruction via the Internet with Prof. Netti and 40% will be in the classroom with Chaplain Stuart. There will be 6 actual class meetings in addition to the course work you will do on the Internet. Class meetings will be on Wednesdays, 16 JUL-20 AUG.**
