**Federal Pell Grant – New regulations**

- In the past if you received a federal Pell grant for full-time enrollment at either Vincennes University or another college both fall and spring semesters, you were not eligible for a federal Pell grant during the summer. Under new legislation if you are enrolled at least half time (6 credit hours), you may be eligible for a federal Pell grant during the summer even if this is more than your usual annual limit. You will have to meet all other requirements for federal Pell grant eligibility, including meeting standards of academic progress.
- If you are eligible, we will offer you the maximum amount you can receive based on your remaining eligibility and your enrollment status for summer. Students who have not used up their usual annual eligibility may be eligible for a federal Pell grant even if they are enrolled in fewer than six credits.

**Federal Subsidized and Unsubsidized Stafford Loans & PLUS Loans**

- If you attended either Vincennes University or another college and received your maximum loan amounts for 2009-2010, you will have remaining eligibility only if you advance a grade level, e.g., from freshman (30 or fewer credits) to sophomore (31 or more credits).
  - You must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours either in one summer session or a combination of summer sessions.

**To be eligible for summer financial aid, you must:**

1. Be admitted under a Vincennes University degree or certificate program;
2. Be enrolled in more than just an Intersession course;
3. Have filed your 2009-2010 FAFSA in time for the financial aid office to receive your FAFSA data before the last day of your summer enrollment. If you need loans, to be safe, file your FAFSA at least a month before the end of your summer session. (NOTE: The FAFSA processing center does **not** accept 2009-2010 FAFSAs after June 30, 2010.)
4. **Students selected for verification by the FAFSA Processing System.**

If you are selected for verification, priority deadlines for submitting the required documents are the following:

- Summer 1 only: Wednesday, June 9.
- 8-week Vincennes Campus evening/Jasper Campus: Monday, June 28.
- Summer 2 or 10-week: Monday, July 12.

These deadlines are set to try to assure that if you are eligible for loans, we will receive confirmation from the department of education about the verification figures we submit to them in time to certify the loans. Regulations do not allow us to certify loans after the last day of the latest session in which you are enrolled. Thus, if you do not meet these priority deadlines, we cannot provide assurance that we can certify any loans you might want.

5. **Federal Stafford student loans and federal PLUS parent loans:**

**Deadlines** for accepting a loan:

- For those in summer I courses only: July 1;
- For those in 8-week courses (including VUJC): July 28;
- For those in summer II and 10-week courses: Aug. 6.

6. Before we can disburse any financial aid, your **final** high school transcript/GED must be on file in the records office.

**Other Eligibility Requirements and Policies for Summer Financial Aid**

- **Federal Pell Grant** – Students who have used up their usual annual amount of federal Pell grant must be enrolled in at least 6 credits to be eligible for the additional federal Pell grant that is available starting this year. Students who have not used up their usual annual amount of federal Pell grant may be eligible for the grant with an enrollment of less than 6 credit hours. Federal regulations require us to recalculate awards for students who change enrollment status. This recalculation may result in students having to repay part or all of their financial aid awards.
- **Child of Disabled Veteran (CDV)** - A current CDV certification must be on file with Vincennes University Financial Aid Office and the student must have remaining eligibility. Eligibility lasts for 124 credit hours.
- **Federal Work Study** - Federal Work-Study (FWS) provides the opportunity for on-campus employment to qualified students. To be eligible for FWS for summer, a student must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours during a single or combined summer sessions.
- **Federal Subsidized & Unsubsidized Stafford Loans** - Students who have already borrowed their maximum annual loan limit for the 2009-2010 academic year will not be eligible for a federal Stafford loan for summer unless they advance a grade level, e.g., from freshman ( $\leq 30$  credits) to sophomore ( $\geq 31$  credits). For those who are eligible, information on how to apply for a loan will be sent with their award notification letter.
  - Federal Stafford subsidized and unsubsidized student loans must be disbursed in two separate amounts. The first half will be released to the student at the beginning of the loan period, the second half at the mid point of the loan period.
  - First-time borrowers must complete an entrance interview before a loan can be activated. An entrance interview can be completed on line at <http://financialaid.vinu.edu--2009-10> button, link #14. Paper version available in financial aid office.
  - First-time Stafford loan borrowers, in accordance with federal regulations, must wait 30 days before receiving the first disbursement of their loan.
  - **Deadlines** for accepting federal Stafford and PLUS loans: For those in summer I only: July 1; for those also in summer II or in summer II only: Aug. 6; for those in 8-week courses: July 28; for those in 10-week courses: Aug. 6.
- **Federal PLUS Loans** – Directions on how to accept a federal parent PLUS loan will be provided to the parents of students who are eligible. See the **deadlines** listed in the bulleted item just above this one.
