Expenses include appearance guarantees and options, athletically-related student aid, contract services, equipment, fund-raising activity, operating expense, promotional activities, recruiting expense, salaries and benefits supplies, travel and any other expense attributed to inter collegiate activities. Debt service and capital expense are not included in these totals.
