Waiver, Release And Hold Harmless Agreement

COACH HARRY MEEKS

With more than 600 victories, Coach Meeks is the all-time winningest coach in VU Lady Trailblazers history. 2015-2016, he led the team to a 29-6 record, an appearance in the NJCAA National Tournament in Lubbock, TX. He also guided the Lady Trailblazers to the program's two greatest seasons while consistently maintaining VU's status among top-20 National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) programs.

Early in his career, Coach Meeks led boys basketball teams at Danville (VA) High School and Woodstock (VA) military prep school. His previous collegiate experience includes 11 years as a top assistant coach at three Div. I schools. He served as a men's basketball assistant for four years at Cincinnati and for five years at Western Carolina. He also served two years at Virginia Tech. In addition, he worked with the top high school women's basketball players in North Carolina and Georgia during summer camps at Western Carolina. Coach Meeks holds a bachelor's degree from James Madison University and a master's from Virginia Tech.

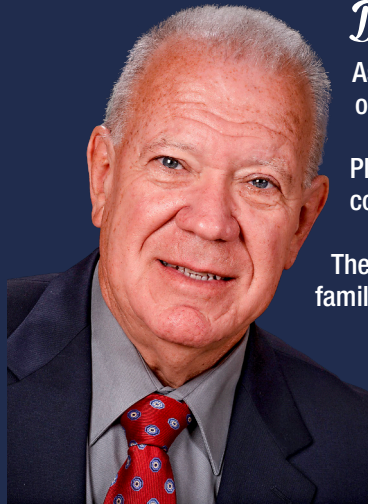
