



Thank you for your interest in the Pharmacy Technology Program at Vincennes University. This program is available on campus and via Distance Education (online) and offers both a certificate of program completion and an A.S. Degree.

The certificate of program completion is designed to provide students the basic skills and knowledge to begin work as a Pharmacy Technician. The A.S. Program is program is designed to provide students the basic skills and knowledge to work as a Pharmacy Technician and assume entry-level management responsibilities in a pharmacy.

The course work for both the certificate of program completion and the A.S. Degree fulfill the Indiana training requirement for Pharmacy Technicians and prepare students to take the National Pharmacy Technician Exam. Vincennes University students do well on this examination and are sought by pharmacies in this area. Although certification is not required in every state, it is required in the State of Indiana.

In order to be considered for admission to one of our programs, **it is very important** that you carefully read through the following information.

The selection process is based on the premise that student selection is vital to the development and maintenance of a strong program. The standards of selection will also contribute to the quality of care administered by graduates of the program. In order to successfully complete the programs, students must be highly motivated and have an academic background sufficient to cope with the curriculum. Compliance with all criteria does not guarantee acceptance to the Pharmacy Technology Program.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Step 1:** Complete a Vincennes University application for admission. By the time you receive this document, you should have completed this step in the process. If you intend to complete the program through Distance Education (online) you must have completed a Distance Education application. **Your acceptance to Vincennes University is separate from admission to the College of Health Science and Human Performance.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Step 2:** Complete the Pharmacy Technology application. **All notifications are sent via email.** All appropriate transcripts need to be on file at Vincennes University to be evaluated. Transcripts include your high school or GED and official copies of any colleges you have attended.

**Test Scores** Applicants that do not have credit for college algebra and English Composition I and/or II are required to complete the VU assessment test (Accuplacer). Arrangements may be made by contacting the Assessment Center at 812-888-5404.
