Camper will be served lunch on Monday & Tuesday. From a selection of an abundance wholesome and well-balanced foods from the Tecumseh Dining Center.

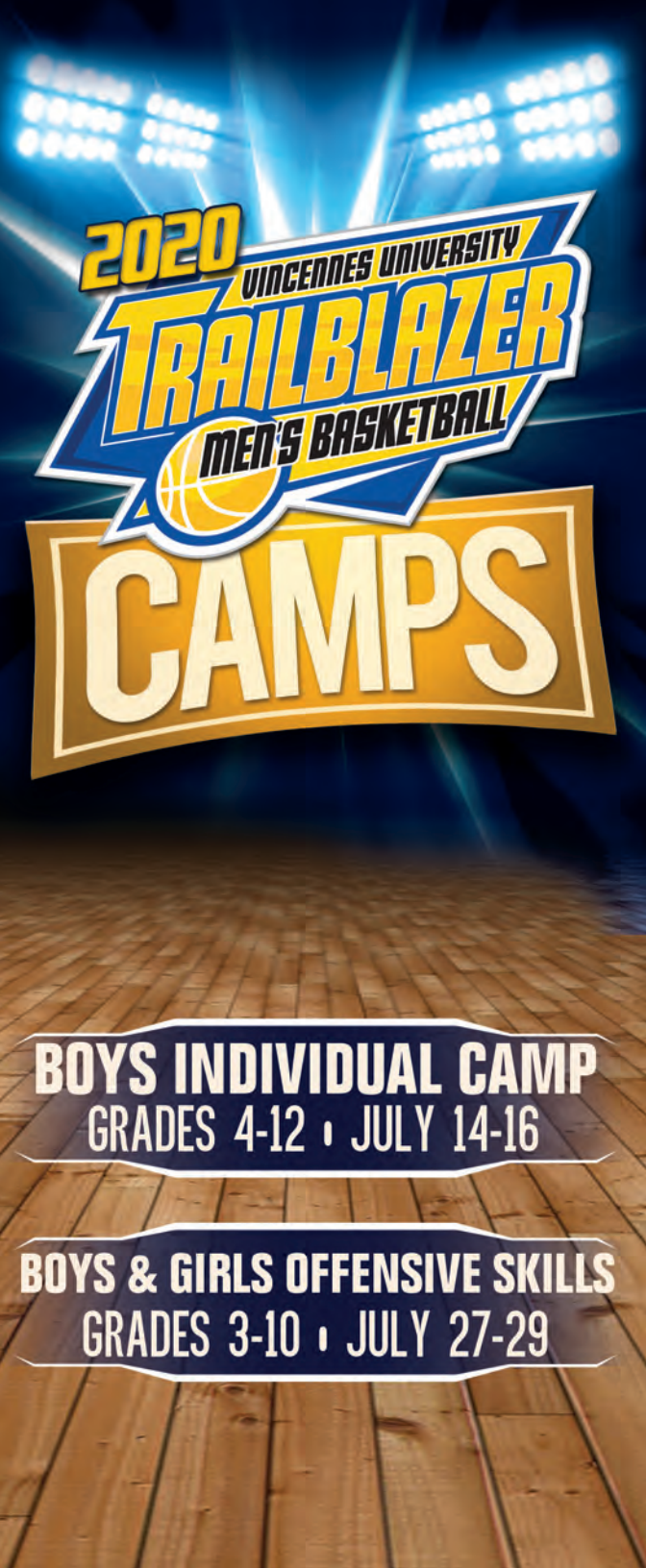
