Dear EPP Leader(s),

The purpose of this letter is to provide a brief summary of the data collected and posted at <a href="http://www.doe.in.gov/licensing/epp-comparative-data-matrix">http://www.doe.in.gov/licensing/epp-comparative-data-matrix</a>. IC 20-28-11.5-9, Sec. 9, (f) states:

"Beginning November 1, 2016, and before September 1 of each year thereafter, the department shall report to each teacher preparation program in Indiana for teachers with three (3) or fewer years of teaching experience:

- (1) information from the surveys relevant to that particular teacher education program provided to the department under subsection (c);
- (2) information from the forms relevant to that particular teacher preparation program compiled by the department under subsection (d); and
- (3) the results from the most recent school year for which data are available of staff performance evaluations for each category described in section 4(c)(4) of this chapter with three (3) or fewer years of teaching experience for that particular teacher preparation program. The report to the teacher preparation program under this subdivision shall be in the aggregate form and shall be broken down by the teacher preparation program that recommended an initial teaching license for the teacher."

In order to comply with the above, we are providing you with the following attachments:

- A copy of the principal and teacher survey results. There is an additional question/response (#34) on the teacher survey that was not included on the web but will be of interest to you.
- A copy of documents posted to our website, as well as the most recent teacher evaluation data reported to the department by school districts. Data posted at <a href="http://www.doe.in.gov/evaluations">http://www.doe.in.gov/evaluations</a>.
