Important!! Please read the notes, below, in order to utilize the Course Listing and Placement Chart information that begins on page two.

All applicable placement scores and course notes/prerequisites/guidelines are listed to the right of the course. Corequisites are listed underneath the course.

MATH – ACT and SAT math scores may be used for select courses. Students must meet course prerequisites and/or have qualifying Accuplacer scores for MATH 104 and 118.

- ✓ Courses highlighted in yellow are currently included in the Indiana Core Transfer Library (CTL).
- ✓ Courses currently approved under the VU CTE tuition fee waiver = no student tuition fees. All other courses are \$25* per credit hour.
- ✓ la - Indicates the course is currently approved on the Indiana Dual Credit Liberal Arts Priority Course List.
- ✓ cte - Indicates the course is currently approved on the Indiana CTE/Career Pathway Priority Course List.
- ✓ cte+ - Indicates although approved on the CTE/Career Pathway Priority Course List, may have higher faculty credentialing requirements.
- ✓ NLPS - Indicates course is approved under Next Level Programs of Study (NLPS).
- ✓ NLPS+ - Indicates although approved on the NLPS Course List, may have higher faculty credentialing requirements.
- ✓ ∞ - Indicates the course is NOT currently approved on either (CTE or Liberal Arts) Indiana Priority Dual Credit Course List or NLPS.

**If the student has an Accuplacer score from a postsecondary institution, other than VU, a copy of the student's full testing report should be attached to the Project EXCEL registration form, for verification purposes.*

- ➔ Credit hours listed - the number of credit hours students will earn on their official VU transcript, for each course.
- ➔ Weekly Class Hours - the number of lecture and/or lab hours the course runs on the VU campus, EACH week, based on a 16 week semester.
- ➔ Total Class Hours - the minimum number of contact hours (lecture and/or lab) the student must spend in the classroom, during the term in which the course is taught, in order for the student to earn VU dual credit through Project EXCEL.

Students may utilize qualifying scores from more than one test administration. For example, a student may use a qualifying SAT reading score and a qualifying Accuplacer Writing score for placement into ENGL 101.

World Language Placement:

Students interested in taking FREN 103/201 or SPAN 103/201 classes must meet course prerequisite requirements or participate in advanced placement departmental testing.
