English Proficiency

You are not required to submit proof of English proficiency (i.e. TOEFL) for admission. However, you will be required to take an English Proficiency test upon arrival (unless you are from a TOEFL-exempt country in which English is an official language). If you do not achieve a satisfactory score you will be required to take at least one semester of full-time ESL classes (16 credit hours). You must pass the ESL program successfully before being allowed to take regular college courses related to you major.

Proof of English proficiency:

- TOEFL score of 71 iBT or 572 paper or higher: contact TOEFL and have your official score sent to VU.
- IELTS of at least 6: have your score sent to VU.
- College reading and writing completed at a U.S. college with a grade "C" or better.
Original transcript from previous institution is required.

All applicants to Vincennes University must pay a non-refundable application fee of **US \$50.00**. The fee must be paid before the application is processed and the I-20 is issued.

Payment can be made by international or postal money order. The check must be in U.S. dollars, drawn on a U.S. bank, and made payable to: Vincennes University. Mail the check or money order with your complete application. Payment can also be made by debit or credit card by filling out the online Deposit Form.
