The U. S. STEP 1: Provide an academic transcript or grade report (can be unofficial) from each institution for each semester or term you received a Federal Pell Grant or Federal Direct Student Loan at that institution during 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18. **Write your name and A#** at the top of each page and send them to us by fax, e-mail, or postal mail. If any transcript/grade report is unclear, we will require you to provide an official transcript.

STEP 2: List on the lines below the name of each educational institution from which you received a Federal Pell Grant or Federal Direct Loan **but did not earn any academic credit** during 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, or 2017-18.

STEP 3: Attach a signed statement to this form explaining, for **EACH** school you list in Step 2, the reason you failed to earn any academic credit at that school. You must **attach documentation** (e.g., medical bills, hospitalization records, accident reports, etc.) that supports your explanations. Be sure to **write your name and A#** at the top of each page.
