

State Summer Guideline 2021

Enrollment Requirement

Students meeting the full-time enrollment requirement can use state aid during the summer without an exception. However, the following exceptions exist for using state aid if enrolled less than full time during the summer. These exceptions apply to the 21st Century Scholarship, Frank O'Bannon Grant, Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship, Adult Student Grant, and Workforce Ready Grant. To qualify for one of these exceptions, students must exactly meet the below enrollment and aid usage pattern during Fall 2020 and Spring 2021.

Degree Seeking

During summer terms, guest or non-degree students are eligible to use the remaining balance of their 21st Century Scholarship, Frank O'Bannon Grant, Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship, and Adult Student Grant award offers at your institution if the award offer has been claimed in a prior term by another institution.

You may consider these students to be degree-seeking for purposes of using these award offers unless you have knowledge that the student is no longer degree-seeking at any institution. This exception to the degree-seeking requirement during summer terms will also apply to Fast Track award offers if the same-year 21st Century Scholarship or Frank O'Bannon Grant were claimed at another institution.

To take advantage of this additional flexibility, guest or non-degree students will need to list your institution on the FAFSA so we can make an award for the student at your institution in ScholarTrack.
