4. Group your selection of work in a sturdy portfolio or box.

5. **Make a copy of your application and information sheet for your records.**

**A NOTE ABOUT PORTFOLIOS:** All works must be presented in a clear, well-organized manner, but need not be matted. Bring these works in a portfolio that can be reused to store and return your work. Bring your work to the Shircliff Gallery and carefully arrange it on the floor according to the signs in the gallery space. ## **AVAILABLE GRANTS:**

The following awards are available for **Art and Design Department majors** through a competitive portfolio jury. These art grants are awarded to qualifying students on the basis of merit, as demonstrated by a portfolio art work and a written statement by the student. Students may receive grants from multiple sources.

**Note:** *Filling out a FAFSA Form at the Financial Aid Office may make you eligible for other financial assistance.*

**Meredith P. Reed Scholarships** are grants ranging from \$100 to \$1000. Award consideration is given in the prioritized order related to applicant residence: 1. Knox County, Indiana; 2. Lawrence County, Illinois; 3. All Counties, Indiana; 4. All Counties, Illinois.

**Foundation Scholarship Grants** are variable grants ranging from \$100 to \$1000.

## **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. Students *applying for the first time* have no G.P.A. requirements for the first scholarship application.
2. Awards are available *only to accepted and admitted, full-time Art and Design (Transfer) Art majors at V.U.*
3. Students who have previously received one of these awards may reapply for another award only if they have achieved a minimum of a *3.0 Semester G.P.A.* or higher for the previous semester.
5. Awards are split between two semesters, unless the student graduates after only one more semester. In order to receive the second half of the award for the second semester of the award, the student must maintain a 3.0 GPA for the previous semester.
