\_\_\_\_\_ Chemistry requirement is met by completion of 2 semesters of high school chemistry with a grade of C or better within 5 years of NURS 100 or 4 credit hour college level chemistry courses (CHEM 100/100L, CHEM 103/103L, CHEM 111, or an equivalent/higher course. Ivy Tech CHEM 101 (3 cr. hr) is acceptable. A 4 credit hour Microbiology course (VU BIOL 208/208L) will supersede the chemistry requirement.

Applicants cannot hold a current grade less than a C in any required course. Course may only be repeated one time in order to earn a grade of C or better. Transfer credit points will only be awarded based on transferability of a course.
